RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All the bonafide students of the school should have their identity cards and calendars with them when they are in the campus.
2. Without the permission of the subject teacher and the class teacher, student should not go out of the class.
3. If any student abstains from the class for a day or more, he should submit leave application with the parent signature to the class teacher before attending the next classes.
4. In case any student absents for the examination he / she should submit suitable written explanation for the period of absence and meet the principal personally along with the parent.
5. The students are required to behave decently and maintain proper conduct both on and off –campus. Any kind of misconduct will result in disciplinary action.

7. The student should actively participate in all school activities and fully utilize the opportunities available for their personal growth and development.
8. Attending the National Day celebration in uniform is compulsory.
9. The jerseys provided to the team members must be used exclusively for representing the institution and should not be misused.
10. Students should take an active part in maintaining cleanliness in both the classroom and school campus.
11. The students should protect the assets belonging to the institution. Severe action will be taken on those who damage them.
12. Decision of the Principal or staff Council is final on all aspects related to the discipline of the student in the institution.

13. The students should adhere to the rules and regulations outlined in the calendar and any breach disciplinary rules will be met with severe consequences.
14. Use of transistors, camera, tape recorder, mobile phones, smart watch, any gadgets obscene pictures / magazines are strictly prohibited within the campus.
15. Miniskirts, sleeveless tops, bodycon dresses and graphic t-shirts are not permitted.
16. Riding two- wheeler motor vehicle to school is prohibited for students due to government regulations, as they are minors.
17. Day scholars or any other students are prohibited from purchasing and supplying any items to the hostel students.
18. Girls are not allowed to make fancy hair styles. Boys shall have a decent hair cut. While long hair, crew cut etc. are strongly discouraged.
19. Giving gifts to teachers or staff members by the parents and students is strictly prohibited.
20. The second installments of fees are scheduled for 1st September to 31st October. Parents are required to pay both College fees, Hostel fees and school bus fees by the specified due dates. A fine of Rs.5 per day will be charged for late payment of fees.
21. The child is not allowed to be taken home during school hours except in cases of health problems. Permissions will not be granted for any child to attend programs during school hours.

Fee Structure and Regulations

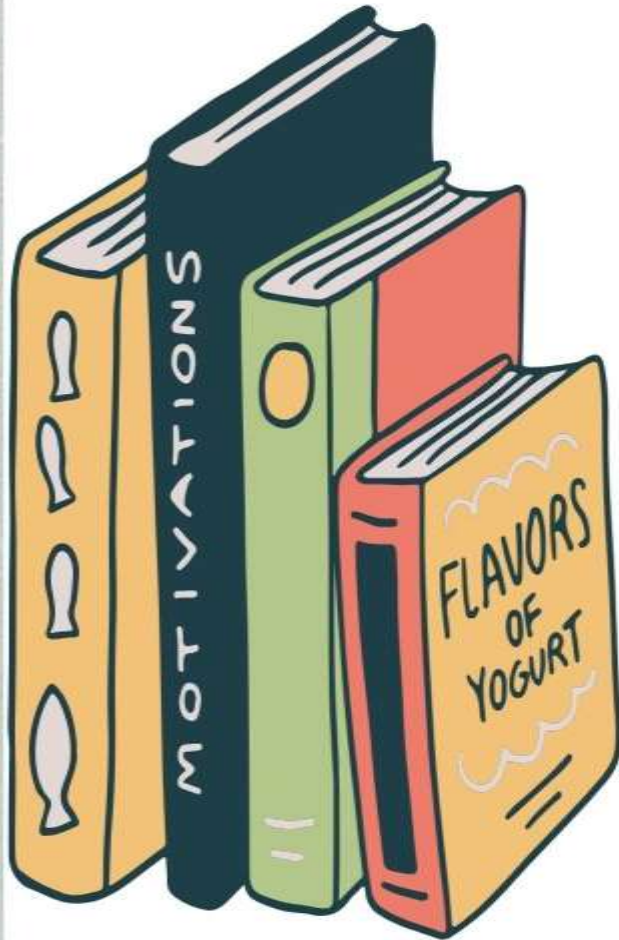

CURRICULUM

1. ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES



- Our college offers an integrated science program that combines rigorous board syllabus preparation with specialized coaching for competitive exams like **KCET, NEET, and JEE**.
- This comprehensive approach includes weekly laboratory sessions for Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and Mathematics,
- Regular assessments like August and December tests, unit tests, mid-term exams (including lab mid-terms), and a preparatory exams
- The academic year culminates in the annual exam in February, followed by a dedicated focus on Class 12 board classes from February to May 15th.
- Regular classes commence in July and we complete the curriculum by September.
- Following the completion of the syllabus in September, we focus on integrated coaching, preparatory work, and revision.
- After the board exams, a crash course is offered to assist students in their final preparation for competitive exams.

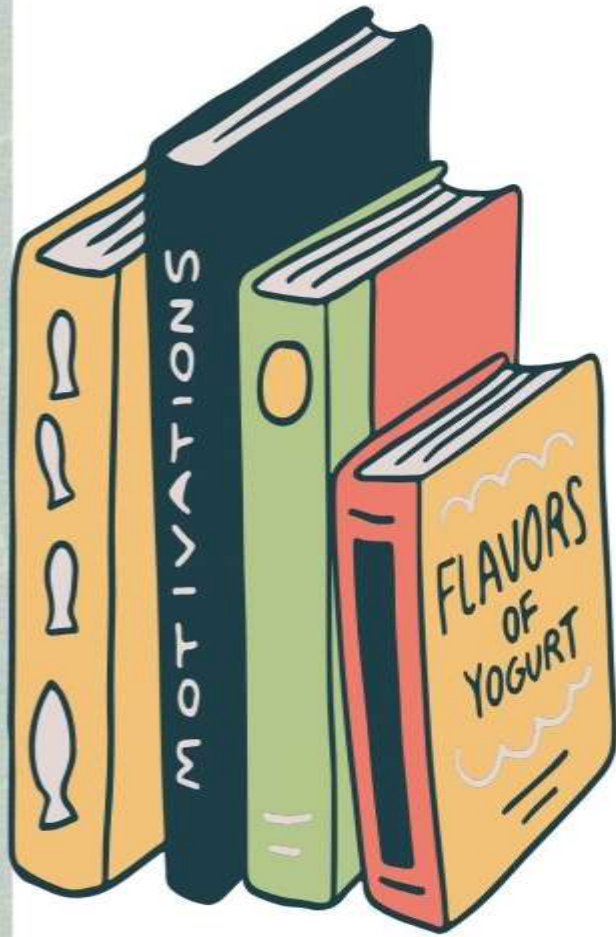
JEE Advanced

INTEGRATED COACHING

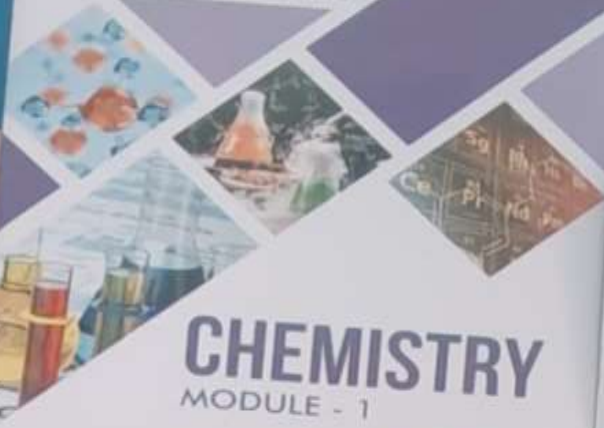
